Please note: Foaling mares must arrive to Maryland no later than 10 months from the Last Date Bred.

Below are the required vaccinations any client-owned horse is to have before arriving to Winbak Farm. As in previous years, a <u>negative coggins test is also mandatory</u>.

If you wish to adopt the Winbak Farm vaccination protocol, we'll be happy to share that with you and/or your veterinarian upon your request. Please be sure to provide a full year's vaccination history, plus a copy of the negative coggins test and a signed boarding agreement, to the Winbak Farm office before scheduling your horse's arrival to Winbak Farm. Notice must be given with the Winbak Farm office no less than 24 hours in advance of the day in which you'd like to schedule your horse(s) to arrive, and all debts must be paid in full before a horse leaves the care of Winbak Farm.
